Of Arts and Crafts origins, this piece is constructed in choice cuts of English oak, the shaped legs joined by a pegged, arched stretcher with plain seat rails. This modest stool offers a simplistic beauty and benefits from a needlepoint seat pad decorated with a tapestry of floral garlands in earth tones. A classic example with solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
