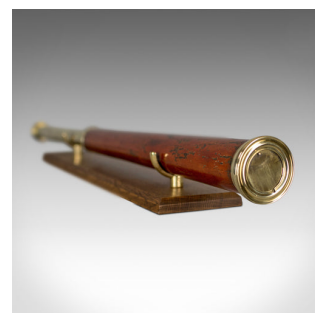
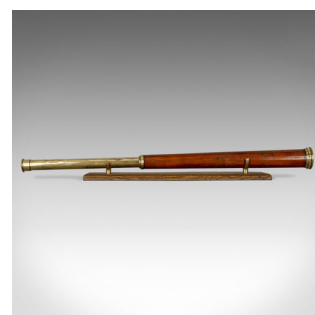


Antique Telescope, English, Single Draw Refractor, T Harris & Son London, c.1810
