- In good proportion with modest lower moulding and shaped crown moulding
- Upper frieze cross-banded in mahogany veneer
- Field panel door with later glazed panel
- Original, solid brass butterfly 'H' hinges
- Original iron lock with working key
- Three serpentine fronted shelves dividing the space within
- Supplied with brass fixings ready to wall mount
