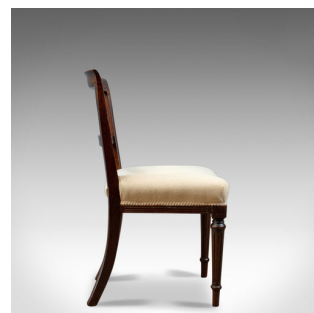


Set of Six Antique Dining Chairs, English, Victorian, Mahogany, Shoolbred, c1840

This is a set of six antique dining chairs. English, Victorian mahogany chairs dating to the early 19th century, circa 1840 and later retailed by Shoolbred, London.

- A superior set of chairs in select mahogany with a desirable patina
- Good colour and grain interest in a wax polished finish
- Craftsman's marks to the inner legs
- Retail badge: 'James Shoolbred & Co., Tottenham House, London'
- Raised on gently tapering, turned and fluted front legs with swept rears
- Classic lines to the shaped stiles, dished crest rail and back rest
- Well executed, reeded delineation to the stiles and crest rail
- Scrolled flute decoration adding interest to the crest rail
- Traditionally stuffed, stuff-over seat pads, easily recovered to suit and décor
- Finished in a classic pale cloth, some minor marks consistent with careful use
- Matching brocade trim finish
