This is a large antique mule chest. An English, carved oak coffer, dating to the late 17th century, circa 1700.

- Superb chest, with striking William III craftsmanship and generous proportion
- Displays desirable aged patina and in good order throughout
- Quality oak stocks present fine grain interest and wisps of medullary rays
- Graced with deep caramel hues, accentuating the delightful nature of the chest
- Two-thirds opening top, the whole crafted from a trio of broad planks
- Folds backwards upon a pair of brass hinges to reveal the pleasingly clean interior
- Lower frame hosting a pair of useful drawers, dressed with a duet of brass drop handles
- Antique iron lock escutcheon to upper edge – untested, key absent
- Field panel fascia with three carved foliate scenes, issuing flowerheads and leaves
