- The shaped top rail narrows gracefully as it meets the horse shoe arm
- A pierced, shaped back splat sits between slender spindles
- Aforementioned horse shoe arms supported at the leading edge by turned balusters
- Traditional, carved saddle seat with gently recessed squab
- Raised upon turned and splayed legs, with collared knees
