- Accentuated with inlay, adding spectral highlights to the stand
- Wide top hosting a striking fretwork circular motif, arranged in eight sections
- Inlaid star motif to the centre and each corner, respectively
- Under tier framed with superb fretwork aprons, culminating in a point at each corner
- Lobed motif adorns the lower edge of the under tier, with circular inlay medallions
- Generous height to the under tier, with a maximum clearance of 40cm (15.75")
