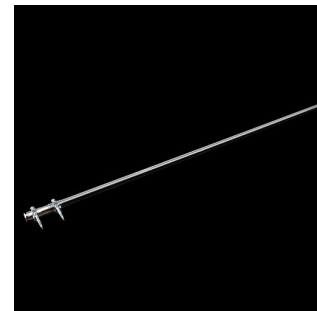


Vintage Beam Compass, German, Cartography, Architect Drawing Instrument, Riefler
