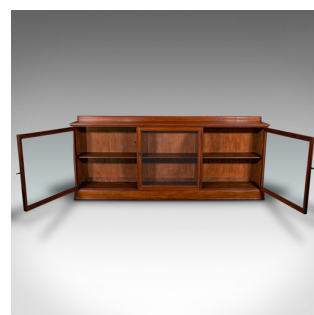


## 7' Wide Antique Museum Bookcase, Glazed Library Cabinet, Early Victorian, C.1840
