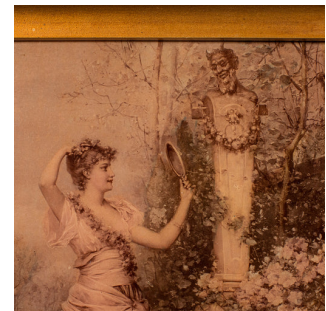


Antique Crystoleum Picture, French, Framed Glass Mezzotint, Art, Late Victorian

- Signed to the lower corner I. Bernoire - likely the mezzotint painter
- Dressed to the rear with mounting wire, for ease of hanging
