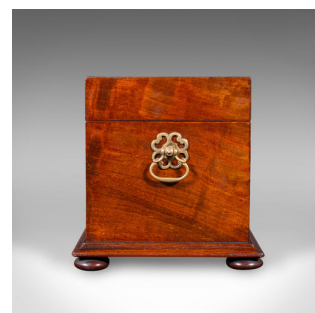
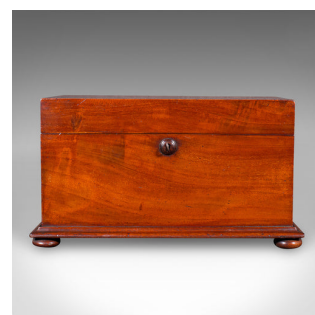


Antique Loose Tea Caddy, English, Dual Compartment Beverage Case, Regency, 1820
