- Select oaks stocks present fine grain interest and wisps of medullary rays
- Warm biscuit hues accentuate the form throughout
- Arranged with a trio of drawers to the fascia over a useful under tier
- Each drawer dressed with brass drop handles of shaped back plates
- Generous nine-plank under tier ideal for use as a kitchen pot stand
- Turned front supports meet block feet, with square section legs to rear

This is an attractive antique dresser base, graced with quality craftsmanship and appealing colour. As useful in the kitchen as it would be in an reception hall. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
