This is an antique coiffeuse dressing table. A French, kingwood extending writing table in Louis XV revival taste, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Exceptional dressing table with concealed functions and a beautiful appearance
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good antique order
- Superb kingwood presents fine grain interest throughout
- Graced with rich caramel hues beneath a quality wax polish finish
- Three part top presents striking parquetry with a quartered chequer pattern
- Central section opens upwards, allowing the side leaves to extend
- Reveals a quality dressing mirror situated upon an articulated rest, with fore and aft movement
- The plate presents minimal foxing and a bright reflection

• Of breakfront form, the distinctive shaped apron hosts a trio of vestigial brass handles
