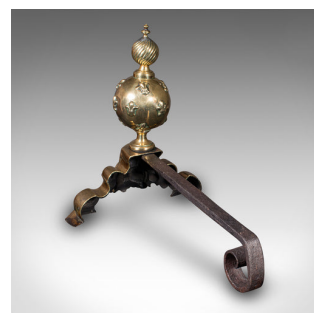


Pair Of Antique Fireside Andirons, French Brass, Chenet, Firedog, Georgian, 1750
