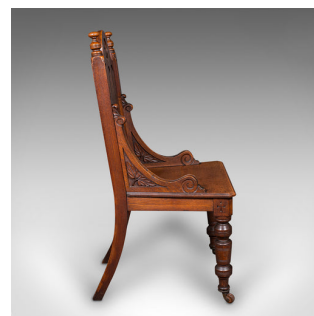
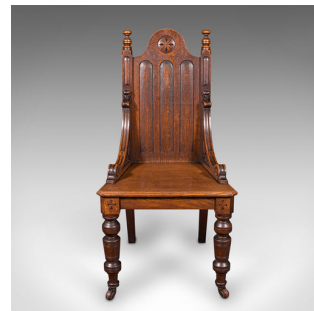


Antique Gothic Revival Hall Chair, Scottish Oak, Reception Seat, Victorian, 1870
