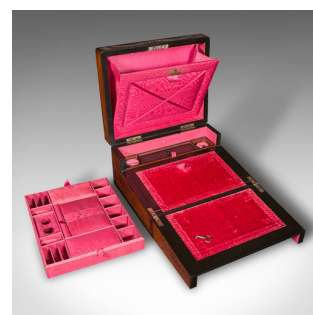


Antique Ladies Travelling Box, English, Sewing Case, Writing Slope, Victorian

This is an antique ladies travelling box. An English, rosewood and inlay combination sewing case and writing slope, dating to the early Victorian period, circa 1850.

- <li class="p1">Opening in two stages, the first aspect being a traditional sewing box
- <li class="p1">Lid reverse hosting a document slide, held securely by a brass twist clasp
- <li class="p1">Removable pin cushion tray replete with six twine bail compartments

<li class="p1">Upon removal of the tray, the centre section opening to reveal a writing slope
