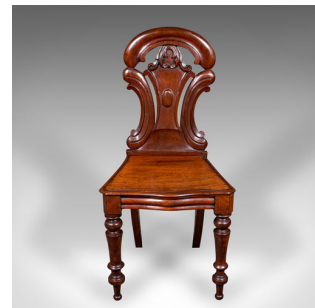


Antique Hall Chair, Scottish, Walnut, Occasional, Reception Seat, Regency, 1820
