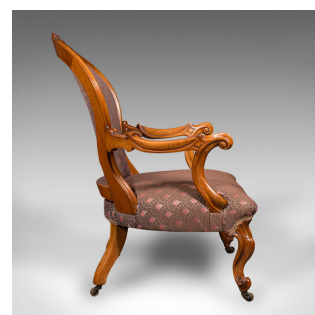


Antique Spoon Back Elbow Chair, English, Walnut, Armchair, Early Victorian, 1840
