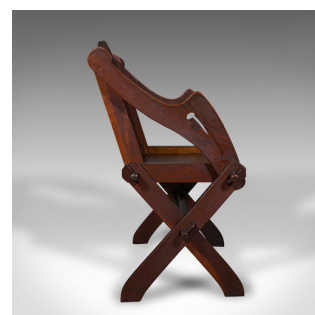




Antique Glastonbury Chair, English Oak, Gothic Revival Seat, Victorian, C.1880
