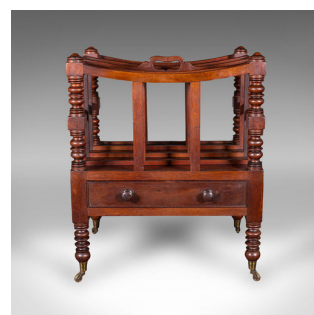
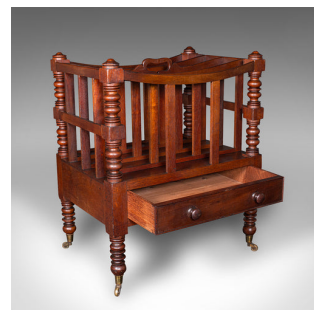


Antique 4 Division Canterbury, English, Newspaper, Magazine Stand, Regency, 1820

This is an antique 4 division Canterbury. An English, mahogany broadsheet newspaper or magazine stand, dating to the Regency period, circa 1820.

- Useful drawer to base adds further storage, dressed with a pair of circular pulls
- Raised upon short turned legs and riding smoothly upon brass castors to each corner
