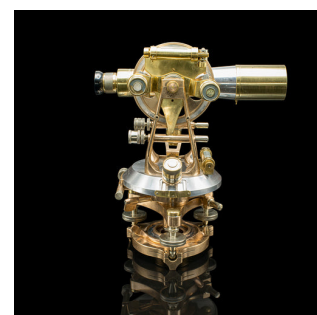


Antique Transit Theodolite, English, Surveying Instrument, Thornton, Edwardian
