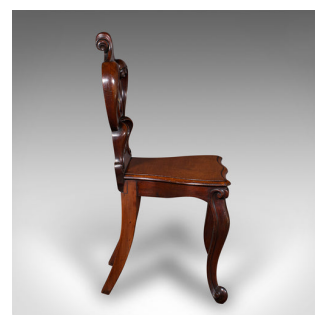


Antique Law Chambers Hall Chair, Scottish, Walnut, Reception Seat, Victorian
