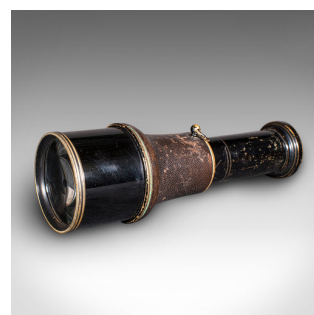


Small Antique Opera Monocular, German, Brass, Leather, Viewing Scope, Victorian
