- Six bar marimbaphone scale, with resonance bells set below
- Plays wonderfully dulcet tones, with a delicate sustain
- Supplied with a soft striking mallet to enjoy upon arrival
- Frame accentuated throughout with flowerhead motif

This is an inviting antique marimbaphone, related to the idiophone family alongside the xylophone and glockenspiel. Of fine quality, with a pleasing, melodious sound. Solid joints and construction. Delivered ready to enjoy.
