- Deep caramel hues grace the panelled exterior
- Arranged as a generous chest over a pair of lower drawers
- Broad two plank top opening upon long iron strap hinges
- Deep interior with the benefit of a covered candle box to the side
- Candle box cover doubling as a support for the outer lid
- Dressed with a diamond-shaped lock escutcheon – untested, key absent
