This is an antique country gentleman's suitcase. A Scottish, leather travelling case, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Superb example with a generous proportion and well-appointed interior
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good, lightly time worn order
- Quality leather, tanned to a deep amber hue and pleasingly intact
- Brass used throughout for press studs, mounts and clasps
- Stout handle with lock cover between a pair of long luggage straps
- Sliding circular clasp with inset lock – untested, key absent
- Opens to reveal a dual division interior, providing storage in each half
- Storage height of 13.5cm within the base and 11cm behind the division
- Canvas lining to the interior in a warm cream hue with light brown leather straps
