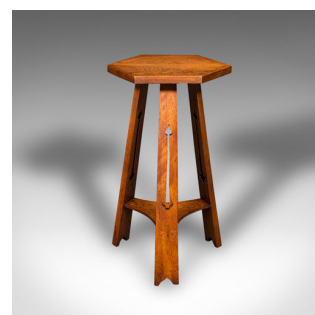
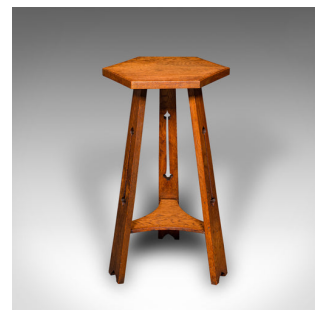


Antique Display Table, English, Stand, After Liberty, Arts & Crafts, Victorian

This is a small antique display table. An English, oak tripod jardiniere stand in the manner of Liberty and the Arts & Crafts movement, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.
