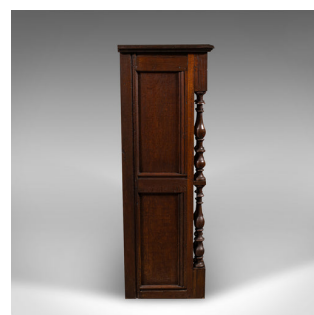


## Large Antique Open Bookcase, Scottish Oak, Gothic Revival, Victorian, Circa 1880
