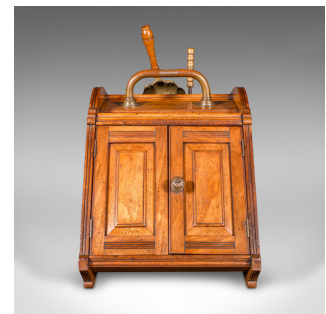


## Antique Coal Purdonium, Scottish, Walnut, Brass, Fireside Fuel Store, Victorian
