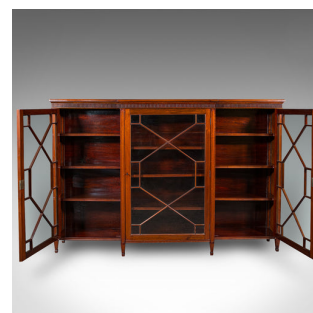
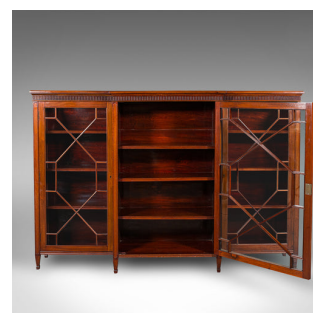


Large Antique Breakfront Bookcase, English, Cabinet, Georgian Revival, Victorian
