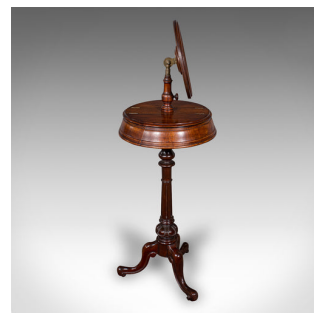
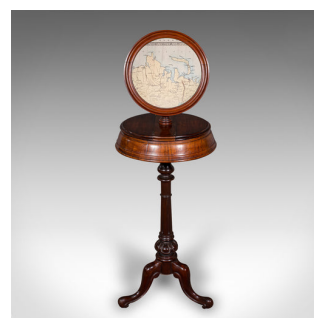


Antique Tripod Shaving Mirror, English, Vanity Grooming Stand, Victorian, C.1840
