- Pull-out writing surface at a comfortable height of 73cm (28.75"), replete with a green baize insert in good order
  - Lower drawer opens to reveal a suite of compartments, perfect for organising documents and correspondence
  - Raised upon a set of bulb-carved, barley twist legs terminating in bun feet, offering excellent support
  - Finished back panel allows for central room placement, ideal for library or study
