This is a striking antique hanging temple incense burner. An Indian, heavy bronze ceremonial censer of impressive scale and intricate detail, dating to the Victorian period, circa 1880. A superb example of temple craft, ideal for grand interior or gallery display.

- Superb Victorian bronze, with fine patination and hints of verdigris tonality
- Crafted in substantial proportion, offering exceptional visual and tactile presence
- Heavyweight bronze construction, tipping the scales at 17 kilograms (37.5 lbs)
- Designed for suspended display, requiring a minimum hanging height of 8' 5" (259cm)
- Suspended from a broad hook with substantial bronze chain links, terminating with a second hook
- \bullet Fascinating decorative detail throughout with elephant, bird, and human motifs in bold relief
- The two-piece incense bowl sits at the centre, designed to hold and diffuse fragrant
- A ceremonial piece of profound decorative impact, imbued with cultural significance and charm
