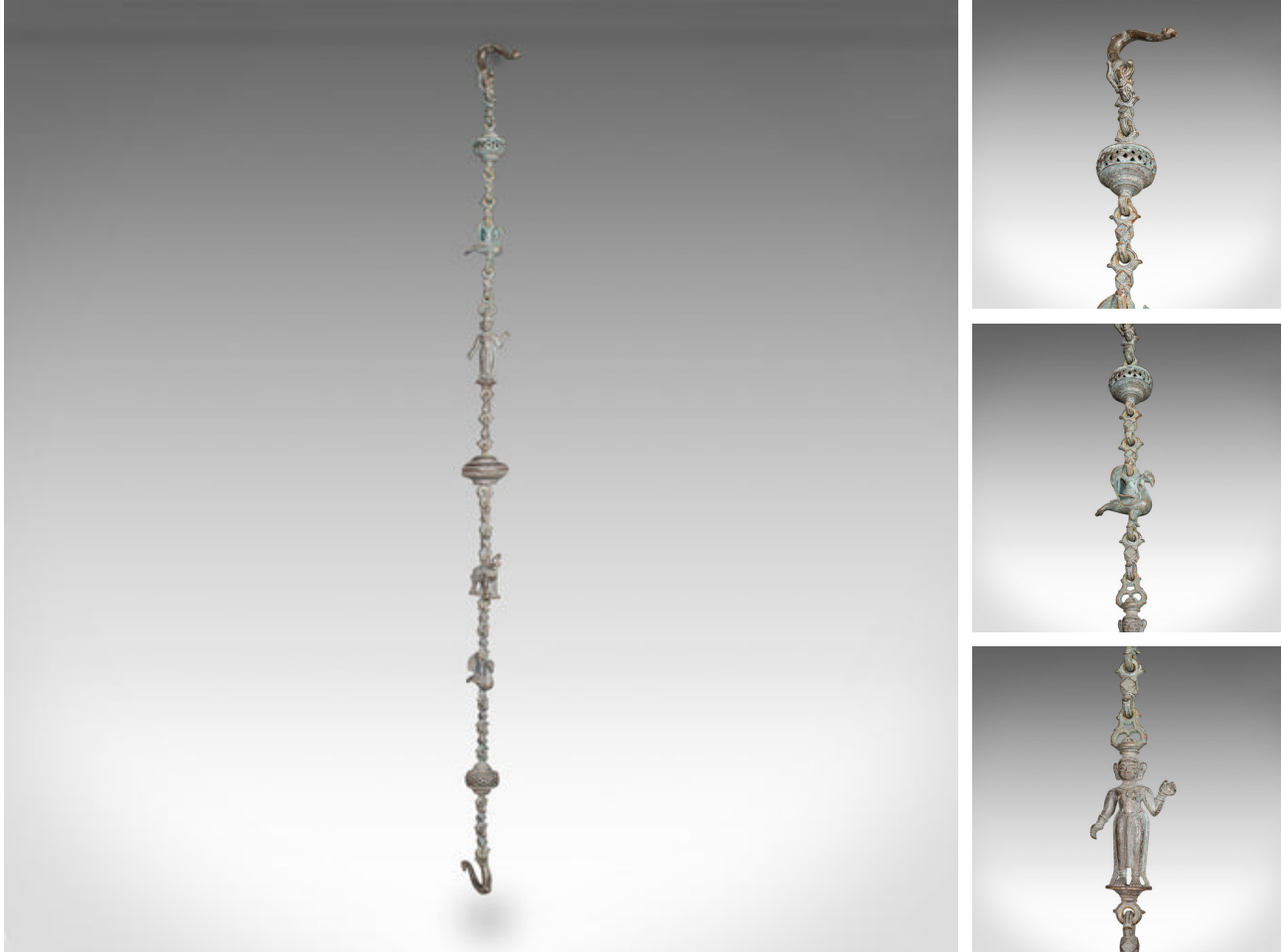


Antique Hanging Incense Burner, Indian, Bronze, Ceremonial Censer, Victorian
