- Pair of drawers to the fascia, dressed with brass lion mask drop handles for period charm
  - Drawer boxes crafted from solid English oak, showcasing traditional dovetail joinery
- Raised upon a quartet of turned legs with collar detail, tapering elegantly to arrow feet
  - Offers excellent utility as a writing desk, console, or hallway table
  - Gently timeworn surface adds character without compromising presentation
