This is a pair of antique hall chairs. An English, oak wing back seat with ecclesiastical influence, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910. With superb colour and estate charm, these chairs are rich in character and form.

- Handsome Edwardian hall chairs with striking ecclesiastical overtones
- Crafted in solid English oak, displaying warm caramel hues and fine grain interest
 - Fascinating estate-made pieces, likely intended for use in a private chapel or entrance hall
 - Wing back form creates an enclosed, contemplative seat – perfect for reflective interiors
- Adorned with relief carved rosettes to the back rest and stile sides, inspired by the rose of Yorkshire
- Shaped seat rails and tall stiles offer a strong vertical presence
- Comfortable seat height of 46.5cm (18.25"), ideal for occasional seating or display
