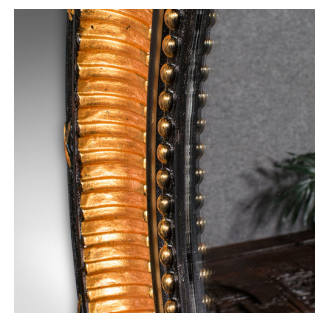


Large Antique Regency Revival Mirror, English, Hall, Overmantle, Edwardian, 1910
