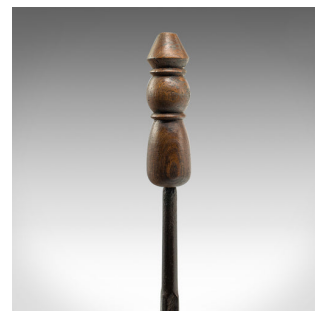


Antique Apothecary Cork Compressor, English, Oak, Wine Bottle, Press, Georgian
