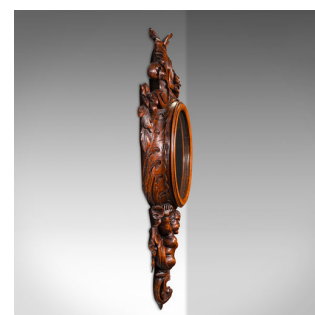


Antique Rococo Mirror, Italian, Carved Fruitwood, Hall, Lounge, Victorian, 1900
