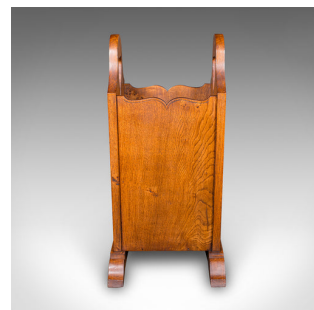


Antique Stick Stand, English Oak, Reception Hall, Arts & Crafts, Victorian, 1900
