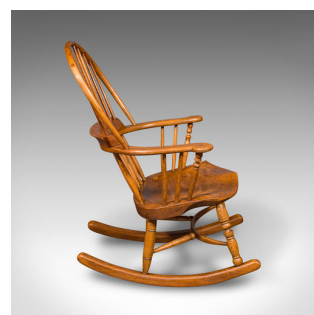
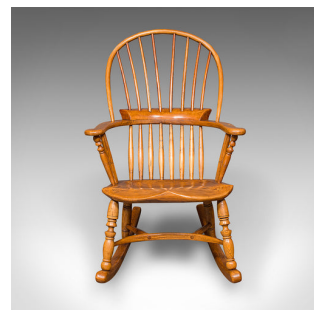


Antique Windsor Rocking Chair, English, Elm, Rocker, Fireside Seat, Victorian
