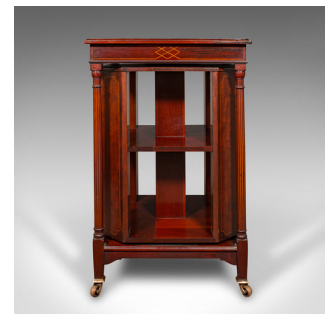


## Antique Rotary Bookcase, English, Revolving Library Cabinet, Edwardian, C.1910
