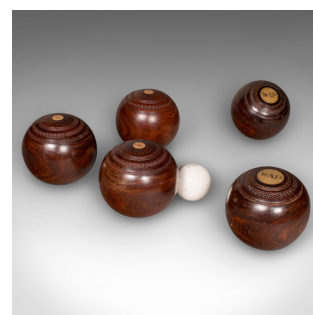


## Antique Lawn Bowls Set, English, Woods, Ceramic Jacks, Garden Game, Edwardian
