This is an antique cylinder bureau writing desk from the early Victorian period, English, mahogany c.1850.

- A super example of its type in light mahogany
- Good colour and grain interest throughout
- Of quality craftsmanship with a smooth opening action
- Raised on a continuous plinth base
- A pair of cupboard doors with brass lattice panels over cloth
- Working lock and key to lower cabinet with dust strip
- A single shelf within divides the space in two
- A pair of turned pulls lift cylinder lid
- Desk slide withdraws easily and smoothly
- Presenting three inset, blind tooled tan leather skivers
- The centre one hinged with variable adjustment over pen tray
