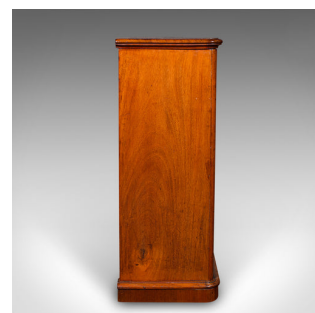


## Antique Gentleman's Sporrans Chest, Scottish, Collectors Cabinet, Victorian, 1850
