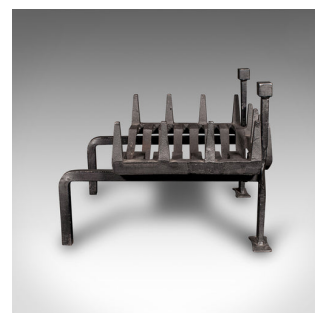


## Antique Fireplace Set, English, Iron, Fire Basket, Pair of Andirons, Edwardian

This is a charming antique fireplace set, comprising an English iron fire basket and a pair of andirons, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910. Offering timeless appeal and traditional craftsmanship, this ensemble is well-suited to both country house and townhouse fireplaces, displaying a wonderfully aged patina and pleasing proportion.

- Of fine Edwardian quality, the fire basket presents in cast iron, its deep form bounded by a classic toothed border
- Resting neatly upon a pair of wrought iron andirons, it delivers a complete and authentic hearth arrangement
- Each andiron displays a distinctive scalloped motif to the centre, a subtle decorative flourish within the simple, practical form
- The ironwork displays a natural patination throughout, enhanced by gentle age and use
- Presented as a desirable charcoal grey tonality across the surfaces
- This finish lends both character and warmth, complementing traditional interiors and blending seamlessly with open hearth settings
