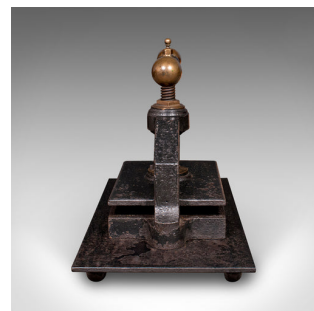


## Heavy Antique Book Press, English Cast Iron, Bronze, Industrial Binder, Georgian
