This is an antique shipwright's tool chest. An English, ebonised pine workman's trunk, dating to the Victorian period, circa 1880. Delightfully authentic and full of maritime character, this robust chest exudes industrial charm and would make a striking coffee table or storage piece in a contemporary or period setting.

- Traditional shipwright's form, offering exceptional character and authenticity
- Constructed from select pine stocks, displaying fine grain beneath a deep ebonised finish
 - Fitted interior with a pair of removable tool trays for organised storage
 - With the trays in place, the chest offers 15cm (6") of storage height
- Lid interior hosts a series of rotating clips, designed for tool retention and quick access
 - Stout keepers secure tactile rope handles, allowing ease of movement and transport
 - Shows wonderful patination and light wear consistent with years of industrious use
- Perfect for repurposing as a coffee table, blanket chest, or distinctive decorative trunk
 - fine example of Victorian functional design with enduring aesthetic appearance
