This is an antique reception hall coat rack. An English, oak six hook wall-mounted cloakroom valet, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910. Rich in colour, decorative in form, and entirely practical in purpose, it stands as an ideal feature for a period hallway or reception setting.

- Central foliate patera motif in relief, gracefully positioned between the two sets of three hooks
- Mounted upon a pair of quality brass loops ensures ease of wall hanging and secure placement within any setting
