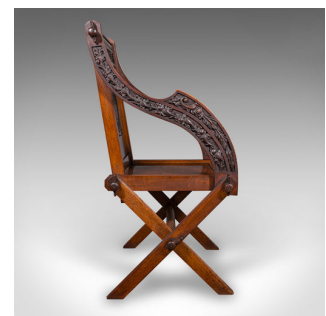


Antique Glastonbury Chair, English, Oak, Elbow Seat, Gothic Revival, Victorian

This is an antique Glastonbury chair. An English, oak armchair in Gothic Revival taste, dating to the Victorian period, circa 1880. A superb example of the traditional Glastonbury form, this distinguished chair exhibits the bold lines, medieval inspiration, and craftsmanship typical of the late 19th century Gothic Revival movement. Wonderfully constructed and full of character, it makes a commanding statement piece for a study, library, or hall.

- Exceptional example of the traditional Glastonbury chair
- Quality oak presents fine grain interest and warm caramel hues
- Wonderful exposed joints a bold feature of the Glastonbury form, as are the striking X-frame legs
- Defined by the distinctive shaped arms, here accentuated with a relief carved foliate pattern

- Crest rail accentuated with a repeat of the foliate pattern as seen upon the arms
- Square frieze to the back rest hosts a flowerhead carved medallion with heraldic portrait to the centre

• The flat, gently recessed seat squab sits at a comfortable height of 48cm (19")

- Legs united with a stretcher rail for additional stability
